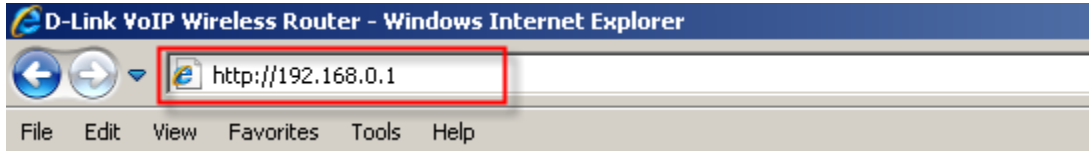


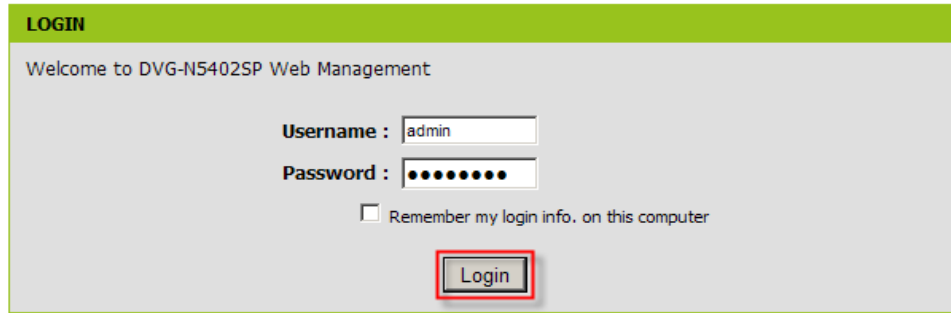
D-Link® Technical Support Setup Procedure

How to Enable IP Filtering on the DVG-N5402SP

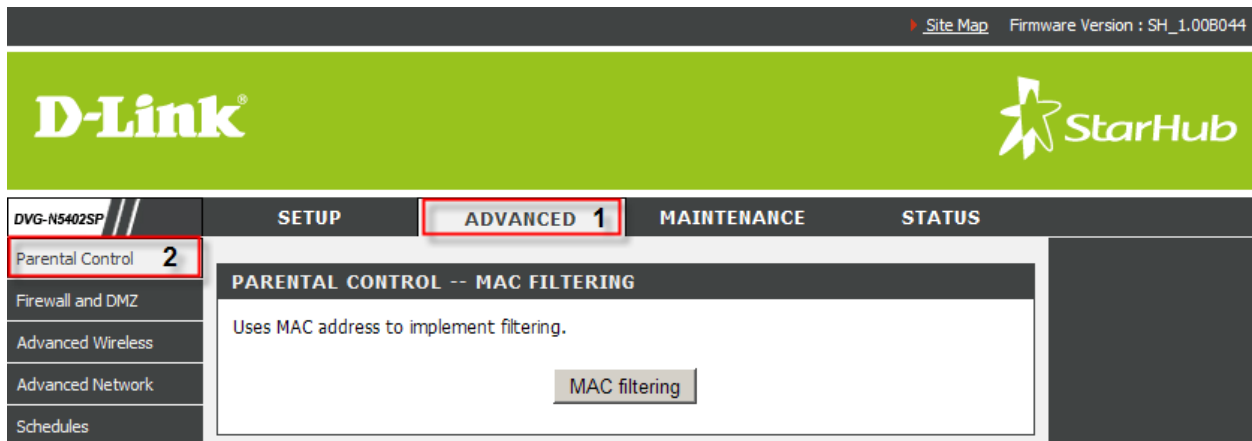
Step 1: Open a web browser such as Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Safari and etc. On the Address bar type in the LAN IP Address of the DVG-N5402SP which is **192.168.0.1** and then press on the Enter key on your keyboard.



Step 2: A login screen will appear, type in the User Name as "admin" and the Password as "password" all in lower case and then click on the **Log In** button.



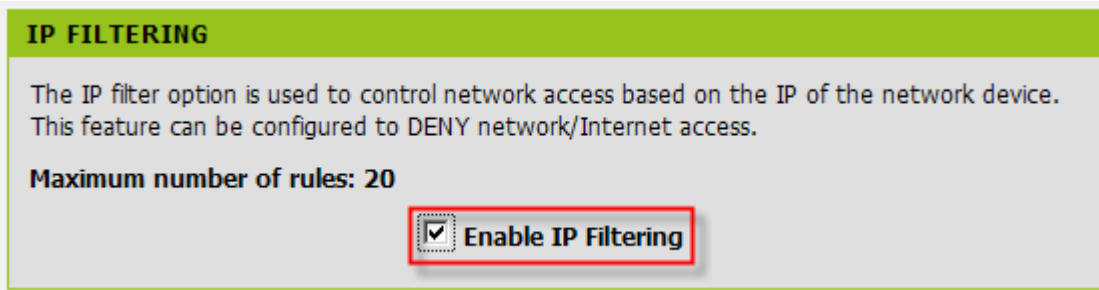
Step 3: Click on the **ADVANCED** tab and then select on **Parental Control** button on the left hand side.



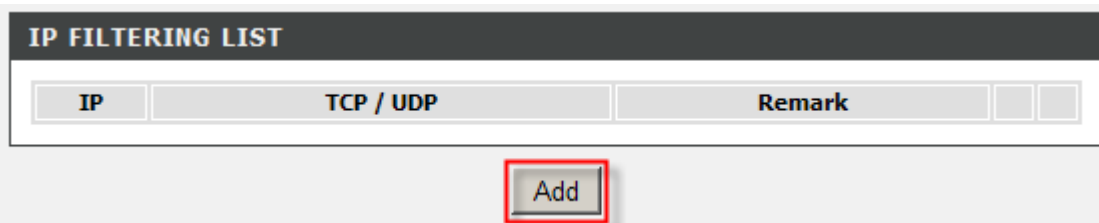
Step 4: Under the **PARENTAL CONTROL – IP FILTERING** section, click on the **IP Filtering** button.



Step 5: Under the **IP FILTERING** section, Put a check mark on **Enable IP Filtering**.



Step 6: Under the **IP FILTERING LIST** section, click on the Add button.



Step 7: Under the IP FILTER section configure the following;

1. **IP:** Enter the IP Address you want to deny to access the Network/Internet
2. **TCP/UDP:** Select either Both, TCP or UDP
3. Click on the **Apply** button for the settings to take effect.
